SYNOPSIS

Recognising the importance of the maritime industry in supporting the country's growing economy, the Institute for Development Studies (Sabah) in collaboration with JBC Solutions Sdn Bhd and KASI Maritime Consultants Sdn Bhd are proud to present the East Malaysia Maritime Conference (EMMC 2005), a not-to-be missed event. This premier event will be held in Kota Kinabalu, Sabah, Malaysia on 22nd & 23rd September 2005.

East Malaysia Maritime Conference 2005 (EMMC 2005) is the stage where experts from around the AP region speak on the many issues that will shape the future of the maritime industry.
